





# INNOVATE AND PROTECT: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY IN BIOTECHNOLOGY

Dr. Soman addressed the challenges faced in obtaining and enforcing intellectual property rights in biotechnology, including issues related to patentability, infringement, and ethical considerations.
